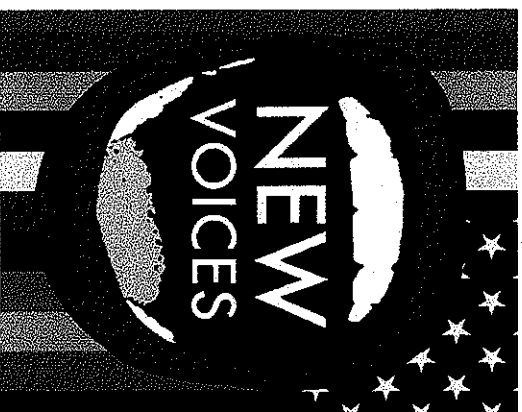
These are not **OUR** democratic priorities. Now is the time to build our strength and prepare for 2012, starting with our third **New Voices Campaign Training.**
